

ORDER

Osvaldo Toledo-Martínez failed to comply with the terms of the Civil Contempt Order issued by the court orally on February 8, 2011, and in writing on February 9, 2011. The contempt order required Mr. Toledo-Martínez to pay a civil penalty of \$10,000 or be incarcerated until paid.
