
ORDER

Oswaldo Toledo-Martínez failed to comply with the terms of the Civil Contempt Order issued by the court orally on February 8, 2011, and in writing on February 9, 2011. The contempt order required Mr. Toledo-Martínez to pay a civil penalty of \$10,000 or be incarcerated until paid.

Due to Mr. Toledo-Martínez' failure to comply with the terms of the contempt order, a warrant of arrest has been issued. Mr. Toledo-Martínez will remain incarcerated at MDC-Guaynabo until he complies as ordered. The key to liberty is in his hands.
