ORDER

Before the Court are the arguments presented by both Parties on whether the Discharge Injunction, previously entered in Case No. 17-3283 (the "Title III Court"), applies to the claims in the current proceeding.

The Defendants assert that Plaintiffs' claims were discharged through the *Modified Eighth Amended Title III Joint Plan of Adjustment of the Commonwealth*¹ and are now subject to a permanent injunction² barring further litigation. (Docket No. 78). In response, the Plaintiffs argue that the discharge and corresponding injunction established by the Plan of Adjustment are inapplicable, asserting that their claims are exempted from the discharge. (Docket Nos. 79 and 81).
